

2024/2025 Enrollment Information

Buckeye USD announces that beginning **Monday, February 5, 2024**, registration for the 2024/2025 school year will be accepted *online*, via the school websites linked below. If you are uncertain about your home school, please visit the district website <u>HERE</u> to input the address of your current residency to access this information. Information about transfer requests is listed below. If you need any further registration information, please contact the school. If your student is currently enrolled with Buckeye USD, you do NOT need to re-register each year.

Age eligibility:

- <u>Transitional Kindergarten (TK)</u>: Children who will turn five years old between *September 2, 2024, and June 2, 2025*, are eligible for and may register for <u>Transitional Kindergarten</u>.
- <u>Kindergarten</u>: Children who reside in Buckeye Union School District and will be five years of age on or before *September 1, 2024*, may register for Kindergarten.

It is important to understand that your child's registration packet is not complete if ALL required documents (pg. 2) required to be submitted have not been submitted to school officials and, therefore, your child will not be enrolled at the time of submission of the enrollment packet, but rather placed on a waitlist pending completion of the required enrollment information. School staff will contact you if your enrollment packet is deemed incomplete and request the information needed to enroll your child upon its submission. (AR 5111 of the Board Policies, Ed. Code § 48002)

Intradistrict Transfers:

Intradistrict Transfer requests are for students transferring between <u>BUCKEYE UNION SCHOOLS</u> (attending a different Buckeye Union school than your designated Buckeye Union homeschool). Forms will be accepted between **January 16, 2024, and February 28, 2024**, for consideration for the 2024/2025 school year. If your student is already attending a school on an Intradistrict Transfer, a move from the student's assigned school to another school within our district, and they wish to remain at that school, they do not need to renew their Intradistrict agreement, and we will assume the student will be returning to the same school for the next school year. Intradistrict forms are available on the Buckeye Union School District website by clicking on "Parent Resources" and then "District/School Transfers".

Interdistrict Transfers:

Interdistrict Transfer requests are for students transferring between <u>DISTRICTS</u> (attending a different school district than your designated home district). Any student attending Buckeye Union School District on a currently approved Interdistrict Transfer Agreement will automatically be registered for the next school year, *unless* 1) the student has a change in school (including elementary to middle school) or 2) the school site is notified of the student's withdrawal. New Interdistrict Transfer request forms will be accepted between **February 5**, **2024**, **and March 31**, **2024**, for consideration for the 2024/2025 school year. **New Interdistrict Transfer requests will not be reviewed until May 13, 2024**. All immunizations must be completed and provided to be registered for school. Students with incomplete immunizations will be placed on a waitlist until immunizations are complete. Once registration packets are processed, if you do not have the required immunizations, you will receive a notification of the immunizations required to complete your registration. Requirements may be found on the CDPH website HERE. Exemptions may only be made for medical concerns through the state and physician CAIR-ME system. For more information, please click HERE.
Proof of residency for our boundaries is not required for our Charter schools: 1) Valley View Charter Montessori School / Middle School IB World School 2) Camerado Springs Middle School IB World School 3) Buckeye Union Mandarin Immersion Charter School For Rolling Hills Middle School: A current PG&E bill with a parent or guardian's name and physical address OR PG&E turn-on service printed from your PG&E online account is required.	Education Code Section 48200 states, in part, that, "Each person subject to compulsory full-time educationshall attend the public full-time schoolin which the residency of either the parent or legal guardian is located and each parent, guardian, or person having control or charge of such pupil shall send the pupil to the public full-time schoolin which the residence of either the parent or legal guardian is located." Residency documentation must show the name and address of the parent or legal guardian residing within the school district. Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must provide valid proof of residency which may be established by documentation including, but not limited to, a combination of two or more of the following documents: • Utility Bills (water/electric/gas — utility service contract, statement or payment receipts) • Property Tax Payment Receipt • Rental agreement or notarized copy of escrow papers, lease agreement, or payment receipts. (Must be verified by a utility receipt within 30 days of enrollment) • Voter Registration • Pay Stubs • Correspondence from a government agency • Declaration of residency executed by the parent or legal guardian of a pupil (available in school offices)

Special Education Forms	IF your child is receiving special education services and has an IEP (Individual Education Plan), please provide a copy for scheduling purposes.
Report of Health Examination for School Entry	Requested in Kindergarten/Required for First Grade This must be filled out by a medical doctor, and turned in prior to first grade - this examination may be given up to 18 months prior to first-grade entry.
Oral Health Information	Requested in Kindergarten/Required for First Grade This report must be filled out by a licensed dental professional and due no later than May 31 in Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, or first grade, whichever is your child's first year of public school. An examination that happened within the 12 months before your child enters school also meets this requirement.
Oral Health Waiver	Requested in Kindergarten/Required for First Grade Unless you have previously completed/submitted this form, this must be filled out by a dental professional and turned in to the school before May 31.
