I'd like to take a moment to thank all the parents, staff members, and former students that volunteered at the Spooktacular. Without your help and support, we couldn't have made it happen. I heard from both parents and students that they had a wonderful time. Thank you.

I wanted to let you know about a couple of things we are starting up at Buckeye. First, we have started inviting students in 1st-5th grade to come to the STEAM lab during lunch. Ms. Ava, our STEAM teacher, will be setting up activities for students to do and we will be rotating different grade levels through on Thursdays and Fridays during their lunch and last recess. Of course, this will be completely voluntary.

ATTENDANCE DATA:

Each year, our students in 3rd-5th grade take the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA). These results are now public on the CA Department of Education website. We use this data to help guide our instruction and look for areas that we can celebrate and areas where we can grow. One piece of data that really jumped out at the district level was the impact of chronic absenteeism and its impact on meeting standard on the language arts portion of the SBA. What we see in the data is 72% students that were not chronically absent met or exceeded standard in language arts opposed to those students that were chronically absent only had 50% of them meet or exceed standard. The scores are even lower for our economically disadvantaged students that were chronically absent with only 26% meeting or exceeding standard. This again speaks to the importance of regular attendance at school.

KIDS CAN FOOD DRIVE:

We are still collecting can foods and non-perishable food items for our Kids Can Food Drive. The food drive has been extended until November 9th. All the food items will be donated to the El Dorado County Food Bank to support local families in need. Let's see if we can fill up my office with cans and show what a small school with a BIG heart is all about.
